The Latin American Summer School in Operations Research (ELAVIO) is promoted by the Latin-Iberian American Association of Operations Research (ALIO) and supported by the International Federation of Operational Research Societies (IFORS). The school is aimed at young researchers and students (PhD, Master's, and advanced undergraduate) from Latin America, Portugal, and Spain, with outstanding performance and an interest in Operations Research, Systems Engineering, and Applied Mathematics. ELAVIO aims to stimulate new collaborations and foster participation by bringing updated, topical OR-related content through plenary talks and mini-courses. The first ELAVIO was held in Chile in 1994. Since then, the school has been held in several countries of Latin-Iberian America. In all editions of ELAVIO, a strong spirit of community has been developed, strengthening contacts among members of research groups of several countries.

ELAVIO 2027 will take place in Montevideo, the capital city of Uruguay, between 21 and 26 February 2027. Montevideo is known for its quality of life, combining modern services with a strong historical heritage and cultural life. The city has a nice river promenade and several green amenities. Moreover, its pace and urban scale invite walking around. The school is organized by the Uruguayan Association of Informatics and Operations Research (AUDIIO), Universidad de la República (Udelar), and Universidad de la Empresa (UDE). The academic activities will be hosted by the Faculty of Engineering, Udelar. Lodging will be arranged at the Dazzler hotel, located within walking distance of the faculty.
